PCA-3 Exam Notice of CCD Batch-41

- A. Name of the Examination: Phase Completion Assessment-3 (PCA-3) of CCD Batch-41.
- B. Date and time: **22 June 2026 (06:00 am to 11.59 pm) and 23 June 2026 (06:00 am to 11.59 pm)**; the exam link will be inactive from 12.00 midnight to 05.59 am on 23.06.2026.
- C. Examination time: 40 minutes.
- D. Total questions: 15x4 (Total 15, each with 4 stems). Question distribution: Module 8- 5, Module 9- 5 and Module 10- 5 questions. Question type: True/False mode.
- E. Total mark: 60; Pass mark: 30. For each correct response: +1; for each incorrect response: -0.5; for no response: 0.
- F. There will be maximum 3 chances of appearing in the exam (1 Regular and 2 Retake exams) if student fails in previous attempt(s) within the scheduled time (36 hours).
- G. To appear in examination, the system will ask for your **a) BMDC no, b) Mobile no and c) CCD-ID no** (you will get your CCD-ID in your dashboard). You must have these three numbers at your hand. These must match with your credentials in the system.
- H. It may be more convenient in computer or tab than mobile phone because of better visualization in larger screen. Keep mobile data back-up in case of power failure.

PCA-3 Exam Instruction of CCD Batch-41

As per academic calendar the PCA-3 of CCD Batch-41 is going to start on 22 June 2026. It is an online examination you will have to appear through your dashboard. You need to follow the instructions:

1. Open DLP website (<https://dlp-badas.org/>) in Google Chrome; click '**Login**'.
2. Enter User ID (**BMDC no**) and Password (**Mobile no**); click '**Sign In**'.
3. You will then enter Student's Dashboard.
4. From left side menu, click on '**PCA Exam**' button.
5. Enter your '**CCD-ID**' (you will get CCD-ID in student's dashboard), and press '**Login**'.
6. You will then be directed to Exam System Dashboard with Exam Instructions.
7. Read the instructions, press '**Verify Yourself**' button, and hold your device before your face.
8. Camera of your device will turn on and take a snap of your face automatically.
9. You will then be directed to exam page; click '**Start Exam**' button.
10. Don't switch the camera off; putting the **camera-on is mandatory**. Students are urged to appear in the exam in closed room; extra or accessory devices, or presence of any other person is not allowed. Camera will monitor and record all the activities; in case of any suspicious activity the exam system will be automatically stopped.
11. After starting the exam click the button of the correct statement (**True/False**).
12. To move to next question, select '**Save & Next**' button; after pressing this button you will not be able to clear the answered buttons.
13. To go back to previous question, select '**Previous**' button.
14. To finish the exam, select '**Submit**' button.
15. Exam will automatically end when the auto time counter reaches 00:00. After your answers are submitted you will receive notification of 'Pass' or 'Fail' (The final result of the PCA-3 Exam will be published by DLP Authority after the PCA-3 Exam link is closed.)
16. If any student does not pass in the 1st attempt, he/she will get 2 more attempts to 'Retake Exam' before the PCA-3 Exam link is closed.
